Defeating the Invaders

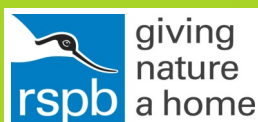
A conference on local solutions to the global problem of invasive non-native species

Invasive non-native species are damaging habitats, competing with native species, and in some cases threatening human health and property in Scotland. Much has been done to try to control them, but there are still big gaps in our knowledge, while some local examples of success and good practice need to be more widely shared. By bringing together as many interested parties as possible, we aim to identify some of those gaps in our science, policy and practice, and find ways to work together more effectively to fill them.
